CHAPTER 355.

AN ACT to repeal certain portions of chapter 136, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of writs and process."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeal.

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and thirty-six, of the Revised Statutes of this State, entitled "Of writs and process," except that part of section two which is in the following words: "The clerks of the several courts of record of this State are hereby authorized to issue and deliver, to any attorney of their respective courts, blank process and seals, to be used in sealing process, under such rules as may be prescribed by the Supreme, circuit, or county courts," is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
