AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of School and University

Lands to assign a certain mortgage.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Commissioners of School and Uni-Authority or versity Lands, upon receiving and filing the written conscious sent of all persons interested in the equity of redemption in the premises described in the mortgage hereinafter named, and upon securing full payment of all sums due thereon for principal, interest and costs, are hereby authorized and impowered to convey and assign to Franz Wagner all the right, title and interest of the State in and to a certain mortgage executed by Ralph Shafferzick, and Mary his wife, to the State of Wisconsin, dated the twenty-fifth day of January, A. D. 1855, to secure the payment of five hundred dollars, together with the note accompanying.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to prevent the sale of unripe cranberries," approved March 17, 1859.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one, of said act, is hereby amend-Amends sec. 1 ed by striking out the word "twentieth," where it occurs of act in said section, and inserting the word "fifth," and also by striking out the last clause in said section, which reads as follows: "Provided, that native Indians shall not be Provise liable to the penalties prescribed in this act."
