## CHAPTER 81.

[Published March 8, 1860.]

AN ACT to detach certain territory now included in school district of the city of Beaver Dam, and to attach the same to school district No. 5, of the town of Beaver Dam, in Dodge county.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The following described lands, to-wit: Lands detachthe south-east quarter of the north-east quarter of sec-ed. tion three, and the north-west quarter of the north-west quarter of section two (2), and the west part of the west half of the south-west quarter of section two, all in township eleven (11) north of range fourteen east, all which lands were, by an act of the Legislature of this State, approved March 11, 1859, included within the school district of the city of Beaver Dam, are hereby detached from the school district of the city of Beaver Dam, and attached to school district number five, of the town of Beaver Dam, in the county of Dodge; and said territory is hereby freed and discharged from all liability or charge Liabilities disby reason or on account of the building of any and all charged. school houses, and by reason or on account of any and all school district expenses, incurred or imposed by the city of Beaver Dam, while said lands constituted a part of the school district of the city of Beaver Dam, excepting such taxes as are levied and included in the tax list of said city for the year 1859.

SEC. 2. Section one, of chapter two, of an act to School disamend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the city of trict of Beaver Dam," approved March 11, 1859, so far as the er Dam. same conflicts or is inconsistent with the provisions of this act, is hereby repealed; and hereafter all territory, and only such territory, as is included within the corporate limits of the city of Beaver Dam, shall constitute one school district, as provided in said section one, of chapter two, of the act aforesaid.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication, and the same shall be published as soon as approved by the Governor.
