AN ACT to authorize the building of ditch and bank fences, as line fences, in certain cases.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

How made.

Section 1. Line fences on marsh or swamp land may be made by digging a ditch on the line, or by banks and ditches combined. Equal amount of material and of space occupied shall be taken from, or occupy each side of said fence: provided, said banks and ditches combined shall not exceed twelve fect in width; and provided, further, that in all cases said fences shall be subject to the decision of fence viewers, pursuant to law.
