There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Bliss, Eberhard & Festner, the sum of two thousand two hundred and eighty-seven dollars and eighty cents, being payment in full for publishing three thousand copies of the report of the state agricultural society for the years A. D. 1858 and 1859.

Deduction.

SECTION 2. The amount hereby appropriated is to be taken and deducted from the annual appropriation of three thousand dollars to the state agricultural society for the year A. D. 1862.
