## GENERAL LAWS.—CHAPTERS 260-261.

## CHAPTER 260.

[Published April 24, 1861.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the State Reform School the sum of money therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any poses appropria-money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the state reform school the sum of eight thousand dollars for current expenses, to be paid in equal quarterly installments; the sum of one thousand dollars to build a carpenter and shoe shop; the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the building of a barn with a cellar under the same; the sum of three hundred dollars for painting and glazing, and the sum of five hundred dollars for the purchase of horses and farming utensils.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force and take effect

from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 261.

[Published April 24, 1861.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin Hospital for the Insane the sum of money therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the For what pur-Wisconsin hospital for the insane, out of any money tion made. in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty thousand dollars, in equal quarterly installments, for the current expenses for the year ending April first, A. D. 1862; the sum of five thousand dollars to pay present indebtedness, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the purchase of stock. building of fence and making of cisterns.
