CHAPTER 266.

[Published April 30, 1861.]

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 110 of the Laws of 1853, entitled "An act establishing the salaries of the Chief Clerks of the Senate and Assembly."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Chapter 110 of the laws of 1853, entitled "An act establishing the salaries of the chief clerks of the senate and 'assembly," is hereby repealed. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Approved April 15, 1861.

CHAPTER 267.

[Published April 19, 1861.]

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of School and University Lands to procure certain maps, plats, surveys, transcripts and appraisements therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

tc of SECTION 1. The commissioners of school and uniini- versity lands of the state of Wisconsin, are hereby authorized to procure for their office, for the purpose of perfecting the records therein, concise and complete abstracts and transcripts of all the original maps, plats, surveys and appraisements of all school and university lands in said state.

SECTION 2. No more than six hundred dollars shall be paid for said complete abstracts, which shall be paid from the school and university funds proportionately; and said sum, or less, as may be sufficient, is hereby appropriated from said funds for said purpose.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
