CHAPTER 2.

[Published January 18, 1861.]

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of the District Board of School District No. 2, of the town of Lowell, Dodge county.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Declaratory.

SECTION 1. All taxes voted or levied and all contracts made, liabilities incurred, and all proceedings had in school district No. 2, of the town of Lowell, Dodge county, for the purpose of renting a school room, purchasing a site, or building a school house in said district, are hereby made and declared legal and binding upon said district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 3.

[Published January 18, 1861.]

AN ACT to authorize drawing the Petit Jurors for the County of Jefferson, for the year 1861.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Duty of clerk of circuit court.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the clerk of the circuit court of the county of Jefferson, at the same time he shall draw the grand jurors, to draw from the whole list selected by the board of supervisors of said

county at their last meeting, as petit jurors, the number required by law to serve as petit jurors, at the several jury terms of said court to be held in said county for the year 1861.

SECTION 2. The persons whose names shall be drawn as aforesaid, shall constitute the regular panel of petit jurors for the terms for which they shall respectively be drawn; and said drawing shall be as legal for all purposes, as if the number of names selected by said board of supervisors had not exceeded that specified in section 1 of chapter 209 of the laws of 1860.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 4.

[Published January 23, 1861.]

AN ACT to provide for the payment of certain outstanding indebtedness against the Swamp Land Fund.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay out of the swamp land fund income, all accounts that have been or may be legally audited for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty, payable out of the swamp land fund: *provided*, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to require or compel the state treasurer to pay any such account which has been, either in part or in whole, illegally audited.

Treasurer to pay

Proviso.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the swamp land fund income a sufficient amount of money to pay the accounts to which reference is had in section one of this act.

Appropriation.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
