buildings on such streets or parts of streets as the public safety may, in their judgment, seem to require.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of James T. Cragin, as town superintendent of schools of the town of Stirling, in the county of Polk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Acts legalized.

Section 1. That all the official acts and duties performed by James T. Cragin, as town superintendent of schools in the town of Stirling, in the county of Polk, in the state of Wisconsin, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this state, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid, for all purposes, as though the said James T. Cragin had caused his official bond and oath to be made and filed in conformity with the statutes of this state.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
