

CHAPTER 178.

[Published April 3, 1862.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 137 of the private and local laws of 1859, entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Winnecone, [Winneconne.]"

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter 137 of the private and local laws of 1859, is hereby repealed. Repeal.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 179.

[Published April 3, 1862.]

AN ACT for the relief of the La Crosse Co. [county] agricultural society.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The time for the La Crosse county agricultural society to make its annual report, as required by law, is hereby extended until the first day of May, A. D. 1862. When order may be drawn on treasurer.

SEC. 2. Upon making its report as aforesaid, setting forth all the facts required by law to entitle it to the annual appropriation from the state treasury to county agricultural societies, the secretary of state shall draw his warrant in favor of said society on the state treasurer, for said appropriation, the same as if said report had been made within the time prescribed by law for making such reports.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
