CHAPTER 196.

[Published April 7, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the town treasurer of the town of Weston, Marathon county, to divide certain school moneys.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority.

SECTION 1. The treasurer of the town of Weston, county of Marathon, state of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized to divide the school moneys collected partly before the town was divided into school districts, among the different school districts at present organized, three in number, in equal amounts, so that each district will receive one-third of the whole fund so collected by said town treasurer.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 199.

[Published April 7, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the fifth ward of the city of Milwaukee to purchase grounds for a market square.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Election to determine whether grounds shall be purchased.

Section 1. Whenever twenty-five or more free-holders, residents of the fifth ward of the city of Milwaukee, shall, by petition, represent that it is necessary for the interest of the said ward to purchase certain lots or lands, not exceeding one whole block, within the said ward, for the purpose of a market square, setting forth in such petition the particular lots or the block which they desire to purchase for such purpose, with the names of the owner or owners thereof, together with the probable amount of money for which such lands can be purchased, the common council shall thereupon order an election to be held in said ward,
