CHAPTER 218.

[Published April 8, 1862.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the institute for the education of the blind, the sum of eight thousand eight hundred dollars, for the purpose of defraying the current expenses of the year.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sum of (\$8,800) eight thousand \$8,800. eight hundred dollars is hereby appropriated to the institute for the education of the blind, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, being payment in full for the current expenses of the ensuing year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 219.

[Published April 8, 1862.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the state reform school, the sum of six thousand dollars, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the ensuing year.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The sum of six thousand dollars is here-\$6,000 by appropriated to the state reform school, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, being payment in full for defraying the current expenses of the ensuing year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
