## CHAPTER 231.

[Published April 8, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend section four of chapter 198 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to provide for the publication of legal decisions."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Distribution of volumes of legal decisions.

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter 198 of the general laws of 1861, is hereby amended [so as] to read as follows: "The volumes so purchased and delivered to the secretary of state, shall be distributed as follows: One volume to each of the several states of the United States; one volume to each of the judges of this state; one volume to each of the circuit courts of this state, to be handed over to their successors in office, and the balance to be deposited in the state library, to be disposed of according to law."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 232.

[Published April 8, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 198 of general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to provide for the publication of legal decisions."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Price per volume of legal decisions.

SECTION 1. That sections three and five of said chapter be amended by inserting after the words "three dollars" when they occur therein, the words "and fifty cents."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
