judge of the county court shall not act in the place of commissioners in the allowance of claims."

AN ACT to provide for the loan and disposition of the drainage fund in the county of Marquette.

CHAPTER 26.

[Published February 19, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 143 of the general laws of 1859, entitled "an act to prevent the sale of unripe cranberries."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 143 of the general laws of 1859, Justice may reentitled "an act to prevent the sale of unripe cranber-fines, &c. ries," is hereby amended by adding to section four the following: "and may retain all fines collected from any person or persons under the provisions of said chapter 143, and apply the same to the payment of the costs of suit, and also to the payment of all liabilities incurred by the county in enforcing said act; and said justice shall, at the next annual session of the board of supervisors of his county, present a certified account of the costs and expenses incurred, and when the same shall be properly audited and allowed, he shall pay over to the county treasurer any balance that may remain in his hands."

SECTION 2. All moneys collected by any justice of Moneys now in hands of justices. the peace, in pursuance of the provisions of said act,

and now remaining in his hands, may be used by said justice of the peace in the payment of such costs and liabilities as may have been heretofore incurred by his county, in enforcing the act to which this is amendatory.

Cranberries may be seized, &c.

to fine.

SECTION 3. All cranberries found in [the] possession of any person or persons in violation of the act to which this is amendetory, [amendatory,] shall be liable to seizure and sale by the proper officers of the county, the proceeds thereof to be applied to the payment of costs and expenses, as provided in section one of this Seller or puract; and any person or persons who may sell or purchaser net liable shape and the seller or purcha chase said berries as aforesaid, shall not be liable to prosecution or fine, as provided in the act hereby amended.

CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend chapter 140 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act to amend chapter 134 of the revised statutes, entitled of executions and proceedings supplementary thereto."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment.

Section 1. Section one of chapter 140 of the general laws of 1861, is hereby amended by striking out the words "as provide in this act," and inserting in lieu thereof, "in the manner provided by law." Approved February 15, 1862.
