AN ACT to repeal chapter 264 of the private and local laws of 1857, entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Waupaca," [Waupacca.]

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the private and local laws of 1857, entitled "an act tò incorporate the village of Waupaca," [Waupacca,] is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The trustees of said village shall have full power and authority to convey "the real estate formerly held by the Waupaca [Waupacca] cemetery association," and deeded to them in trust by said association, to any cemetery association that may hereafter be organized in said village, or otherwise disposed of according to law.

SECTION 3. The officers of said village elected by virtue of said chapter, shall have full power and authority to complete and finish any unfinished business commenced by them as such officers, and now pending before them, notwithstanding the expiration of their term of office.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May, A. D. 1862.
