Monthly payments. SECTION 5. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to authorize any collector to retain in his hands any taxes already collected by him; and every collector is hereby required to pay over to the proper officer or person, such taxes as he may have collected, on the first Monday of every month, until the time shall have elapsed to make his return as hereinbefore provided.

SECTION 6. This act is hereby declared to be in force

from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 39.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of H. H. Tredwell, a justice of the peace of Crystal Lake, Marquette county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Official acts legalized. SECTION 1. That all the official acts and duties performed by H. H. Tredwell, as justice of the peace in the town of Crystal Lake, in the county of Marquette, in this state, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this state, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid, for all purposes, as though the said H. H. Tredwell had caused his official bond and oath to be made and filed in conformity with the statutes of this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
