the second Monday of August, in each year. The hour of such meeting shall be seven o'clock in the afternoon, unless otherwise provided by a vote of the district, duly recorded, at the last annual meeting.

SECTION 2. So much of any act heretofore passed as conflicts with the provisions of this act, is hereby re-

pealed.

## CHAPTER 51.

[Published February 28, 1862.] 2

AN ACT to authorize and empower the city council of the city of Fond du Lac to extend the time for the collection of taxes in said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Not to exceed 60 days.

Section 1. The city council of the city of Fond du Lac shall have power, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to extend the time for the collection of taxes in said city, for such period of time, not exceeding sixty days, as the said city council shall deem necessary. The authority hereby given shall in no way impair or delay the prompt payment of the state and county taxes in each year, as is now provided by law, and such state and county taxes shall be paid in each year at the times and in such manner as is now by law required.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
