have not been paid; and the county treasurer shall proceed to sell the lands upon which the taxes remain unpaid, according to law.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 61.

[Published March 5, 1862.]

AN ACT to pay the general fund for stationery furnished the war department.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Transfer.

SECTION 1. The secretary of state and state treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to transfer from the war fund in the treasury of this state, to the general fund, the sum of one thousand two hundred and eighty dollars and ninety-six cents, and charge the same when so transferred [transferred] to the war fund, and credit the same to the general fund, it being the amount paid from the general fund for stationery (and) furnished the military departments in this state for the use of the general government, to December 31st, 1861.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
