CHAPTER 75.

[Published March 10, 1862.]

AN ACT to legalize the assessment roll of the town of Franklin, Manitowoc county, Wisconsin, for the year 1861.

CHAPTER 76.

[Published March 10, 1860.]

AN ACT to exempt certain articles from attachment, execution or sale on final process.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any sword, plate, books, or other articles exemptcles, presented or given to any person by congress, the legislature of either of the United States, or by either body of congress or of such legislature, whether presented by a vote or raised by subscription of the members of either of the aforesaid bodies, shall be and forever remain exempt from attachment, execution or sale, on any final process issued from any court in this state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
