The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorbe sensed in far i ized and directed to issue an order upon the state treasurer, in favor of the Outagamie county agricultural society, pursuant to section five of chap. [chapter] 53 [of the] general laws of 1858, in the same manner as though the annual report of said society had been received in [on] the first day of February, 1862: provided, said report be on file in the office of the secretary of state at the time of the passage of this act.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT instructing the commissioners of school and university lands to deed certain lands therein described to Martin Clancey.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The commissioners of school and university lands are hereby required to issue a patent to Martin Clancey, of the south-west quarter of the south-east quarter, and the west half of the north-west quarter of the south-east quarter of section number twenty, in township number five north, range number twenty east.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
