

CHAPTER 7.

[Published February 20, 1863.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the city of Janesville, county of Rock, and state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection and return of the state and county taxes in the city of Janesville, Rock county, is hereby extended until the ninth day of March, A. D. 1863, and the tax warrant, now in the hands of the city treasurer, shall be in full force until the said ninth day of March, A. D. 1863, for all the purposes of collecting, levying, distress and sale, and returning said taxes: *provided*, that nothing in this act shall be construed to extend the time for the payment of the state tax to the county treasurer, as now provided by law.

Extended until

Proviso.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 8.

[Published February 21, 1863.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 118 of the private and local [general] laws of 1861, entitled "an act to detach certain lands from the city of Sheboygan, and annex the same to the town of Sheboygan, in the county of Sheboygan," approved March 26, 1861.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 118 of the private and local [general] laws of 1861, is hereby amended, by inserting after the word [words] "twenty-seven," where it occurs [they occur] in the third line of said section, the words "and the south-west quarter of section fifteen."

Amendment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
