

CHAPTER 89.

[Published March 26, 1863.]

AN ACT for the protection of boarding-house keepers, and of livery-stable keepers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The keeper of a boarding-house shall have the same lien upon and right to detain the baggage and effects of any boarder, for the amount which may be due for board by such boarder, to the same extent and in the same manner as inn-keepers have such lien and such right of detention.

Lien of boarding-house keepers.

SECTION 2. This act shall not effect [affect] the law in regard to keepers of emigrant boarding-houses.

Emigrant boarding-houses.

SECTION 3. The keeper of a livery or boarding-stable shall have a lien upon the horses, mules or cattle kept by any such keeper, for the amount of the costs and charges of keeping, supporting and care thereof.

Lien of livery stable keepers. &c.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT to authorize the city clerk of the city of La Crosse to cause to be published a list of all unredeemed lots and lands sold by the city treasurer of said city, in the year 1860, for the taxes, interest and charges due thereon for the year 1859.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That the city clerk of the city of La Crosse shall cause to be published in a newspaper printed in said city, a list of all unredeemed lots and lands which were sold by the city treasurer of said city, in the year 1860, for the taxes, interest and charges thereon of the year 1859, once a week for twelve suc-
