NUMBER 1.

JOINT RESOLUTION asking the government of the U. S. to make a grant of land for the construction of a wagon road from Copper Harbor, state of Michigan, to the city of Appleton, in the state of Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, The legislature of the state of Michigan has passed a joint resolution, asking the government of the U.S. to make a grant of lands for the construction of a waggon [wagon] road from Copper Harbor, running through or to town 40, north of range 37 west, in the state of Michigan, to the city of Appleton, in the state of Wisconsin, of two sections to each mile of wagon road, to be constructed between the points above named; and

WHEREAS, We are confident in the belief that the said grant of lands will be a material benefit to the state, by opening up the country to farming and mining enterprises, and to the general government, by bringing the public lands into market and settle-

ment for actual cultivation: therefore, be it

Resolved, by the senate, the assembly concurring, That our senators in congress be instructed and our representatives requested to use all honorable means to secure the immediate grant of these lands for the purpose set forth in the preamble to these resolutions.

Further, resolved, That the governor be requested to transmit copies of the foregoing preamble and resolutions to our senators and representatives in congress.
