CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT to legalize the formation of a certain school district therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Legalized.

SECTION 1. The formation of school district number fourteen, of the town of Millville, in the county of Grant, is hereby legalized and declared valid, to the same extent as if all required notices had been given and all the requirements of law had been complied with in the formation of the said district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 106.

[Published March 7, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the jury-lists of the county of Dodge, for the year 1864.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Jury-Mote legal-)

SECTION 1. The lists of grand and petit jurors adopted by the board of supervisors of Dodge county, at their annual session in November, A. D. 1868, and certified by the clerk of said board of supervisors to the clerk of the circuit court of said county, on the 25th day of January, A. D. 1864, are hereby made and declared to be legal and valid in every respect, as fully as they would have been if said grand jury-list had contained the names of seventy-five jurors, and the said petit jury-list had contained the names of ninety-six iurors.

SECTION 2. This act shall be published immediately, and shall take effect when published.
