1864, for which year said salary may be fixed and determined by said common council at any time before the charter election for said year.

SECTION 3. The salary thus fixed and determined How salary to be upon, shall be paid out of the city treasury out of any paid. moneys not otherwise appropriated, and may be paid at the end of every quarter.

SECTION 4. The fees now allowed by law to the Fees to be paid treasurer of said city, shall be collected by him and

paid into the city treasury for the use of said city.

SECTION 5. All acts and parts of acts conflicting Repeal. with this act, are, for the purposes of said act only, hereby repcaled.

To all the terms of the said

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to change the time of holding annual meetings in school district number five, in the town of Wauwstoea.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual meetings in school district To be held last Monday of Sopt. number five, in the town of Wauwatosa, shall hereafter be held on the last Monday of August, in each year. The hour of such meeting shall be seven o'clock in the afternoon, unless otherwise ordered by a vote of the district, duly recorded, at the last annual meeting.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
