

stock of said bank is reduced; and from and after filing of such certificate, the capital stock of said bank shall be so reduced, and not before.

SECTION 3. The name of said bank is hereby changed from Green Bay bank to La Crosse bank, by which last name it shall be hereafter known and do business, with all the powers, franchises, rights and privileges, of every description, that it had before such change of name, and subject to all the obligations, duties and liabilities of every class and nature to which the said bank under its name of Green Bay bank has become subject or in any way liable: *provided*, that this act so far as it provides for a change of the name of said bank, shall not be in force until said bank shall have filed duplicate certificates, duly acknowledged by its proper officers, that its name has been so changed, one with the bank comptroller and one in the office of the register of deeds in La Crosse county.

Name may be changed to La Crosse bank.

SECTION 4. It shall not be lawful for the bank comptroller to issue to the said bank any circulating notes, until its plates shall be so altered as to read "La Crosse bank," instead of "Green Bay bank."

CHAPTER 285.

[Published April 7, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of a special town meeting held in and for the town of Windsor, Dane county, on the 16th day of February, A. D. 1864, and to authorize the disbursement of the money voted to be raised by tax at such meeting.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All of the proceedings of the special town meeting held in the town of Windsor, Dane county, on the 16th day of February, A. D. 1864, for the purpose of voting a tax to pay bounties to volunteers, are hereby legalized, and the tax levied and apportioned upon the taxable property of said town, pursuant to and in accordance with the votes had at such special

town meeting, is hereby declared valid and binding; and the treasurer of said town is hereby authorized and required to proceed in the collection of such tax, and to make returns to the county treasurer of the delinquent taxes which he may be unable to collect, in the same manner as he is by law authorized to proceed in the collection of other taxes, and the return of delinquent taxes; and the county treasurer of the county of Dane is hereby authorized and required to receive and treat the returns of delinquent taxes by said treasurer of the town of Windsor, of said special tax, in the same manner as now provided by law for the receipt and treatment of returns of other delinquent taxes. The time for the collection of such special tax, and the making of returns to the county treasurer of the delinquent taxes of said town of Windsor, is hereby extended until the first day of April, A. D. 1864.

SECTION 2. The supervisors of the town of Windsor are hereby authorized to employ the money raised by such special tax for the purpose of paying bounties to the volunteers in the military service of the United States, who may have heretofore or shall hereafter enlist and become credited to such town of Windsor; and the certificate of the adjutant general of this state of such enlistment and credit, and the receipt of such volunteer for the amount, shall be sufficient voucher for the expenditure of such money: *provided*, that no greater sum shall be paid to any one volunteer than was authorized to be paid at such special town meeting.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
