The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections one, two and four of chapter repeal one hundred and ninety of the general laws of 1862, entitled "an act relating to the allotment commissioners, their duties and compensation," are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 248.

AN ACT to authorize the governor to purchase flags.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever the state or national flags of old flags may be any regiment or battery in the service of the United ones.
