CHAPTER 289.

[Published April 18, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend the charter of the "Saint Croix and Lake Superior railroad company."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Saint Croix and Lake Superior special meetings railroad company are hereby authorized to adopt by of state. laws to provide for holding special meetings of the directors and stockholders of said company, at any place or places not within the boundaries of this state, and the acts and proceedings of all meetings other than annual meetings, of either the said directors or stockholders so held in conformity to the by-laws of said company, shall be as binding and valid as if the said meetings were held within the state.

Smorion 2. Any section of the charter of the Saint Amendment. Croix and Lake Superior railroad company, containing provisions controverting the provisions of section one of this act, is so amended as to conform to this act in

all respects.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to incorporate the German Evangelical Lutheran synod of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That Johannes Bading, Philipp Koch-Corporatorsler, Daniel Huber, Gottlieb Reim, C. F. Goldsmarer and their associates and successors, be and are hereby created a body politic and corporate, under the name and style of "the German Evangelical Lutheran syned powers."
