sonal estate and property, transact business, and bind himself by his contracts, devise and bequeath real and personal property, sue and be sued in all the courts of this state, the same and in the same manner, in all respects, as if he were of the full age of twenty-one years.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in full

force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 294.

AN ACT to legalize a special town meeting held in the town of Courtland, Columbia county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Proceedings Ingalisms, SECTION 1. The special town meeting held in the town of Courtland, Columbia county, on the fourth day of February, 1864, for the purpose of raising a special tax to pay extra bounties to volunteers into the military service of the United States, is hereby declared legal and valid for all intents and purposes for which the same was held; and all acts done in pursuance of the vote or votes of said meeting, by the officers of said town, or any of them, or of the persons who acted as inspectors of election at said special town meeting, are hereby declared valid, the same as if the law had been fully complied with in notifying and conducting said meeting.

Smorion 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
