AN ACT relating to the fees of registers of deeds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Fees of registers in certain cases.

SECTION 1. The fees of registers of deeds for any services specified in chapter one hundred and sixty-eight of the general laws of 1860, to be rendered by them, shall be as follows: For entering any copy of sheriff's certificate or writ of attachment of real estate, or certificate of sale of real estate, twenty-five cents; for notice of the pendency of any action affecting the title to real property, containing not more than twenty defendants, twenty-five cents, and twenty-five cents in addition for every additional twenty defendants.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
