The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter two hundred and five of the private and local [general] laws of 1862, entitled an act to amend chapter two hundred and fifty-two of the private and local laws of 1858, entitled an act to amend an act to incorporate the city of La Crosse, approved March 14th, 1856, May 15th, 1858, and April 4th, 1862, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That chapter one hundred and sixteen of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to amend chapter two hundred and five of the private and local [general] laws of 1862, entitled 'an act to amend chapter two hundred and fifty-two of the private and local laws of 1858, entitled 'an act to amend an act to incorporate the city of La Crosse, approved March 14th, 1856," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
