CHAPTER 377.

AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-two of the private and local laws of 1858, entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Ripon, and the several acts amendatory thereto."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The justices of the peace in said city of Justices to be Ripon shall hereafter be elected by general ticket, the eral ticket. same as mayor is now elected.

SECTION 2. The aldermen of each ward shall be the Inspectoral inspectors of elections in such ward.

SECTION 3. All of said chapter seventy-two and of Repeal. the several acts amendatory thereto, conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the city of La Crosse," approved March 14, 1856.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter eight of the act Pire marshal. entitled "an act to incorporate the city of La Crosse," approved March 14, 1856, is hereby amended, by striking out the words, "fire wardens," where the same occur, and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "fire marshal."

SECTION 2. Section five of said chapter is hereby His appointamended, by striking out the words, "At the same time the members of said company shall nominate and the common council shall appoint the same, three fire wardens, one of whom shall reside in each ward," and insert1
