

CHAPTER 423.

[Published April 28, 1864.]

AN ACT to reduce the width of a part of Hill street, in the fourth ward of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

May be reduced
to 70 feet.

SECTION 1. So much of Hill street as lies between the east line of Clermont street and the east line of the alley running through blocks numbered 182 and 187, in the fourth ward of the city of Milwaukee, is hereby reduced in width from eighty feet to seventy feet.

Reduction to be
made on south
side.

SECTION 2. The said reduction of width shall be made from the south side of said street, the north line of said street remaining as it at present is, and the south line of the said street shall be hereafter ten feet north of the present south line of the said street.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
