AN ACT to amend section 216 of chapter 120 of the revised statutes, entitled "of courts held by justices of the peace."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Town of Linwood may vote on question of aid to certain bridge, SECTION 1. The town of Linwood, in the county of Portage, is hereby authorized to aid in the construction of a bridge across the Wisconsin river, in town twenty-four north, of range eight east, to the amount of one thousand dollars: provided, that no such aid shall be given until a majority of the voters of said town voting on the question, shall, at some regular town meeting, general election or special town meeting called for that purpose, vote to give such aid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after

its passage and publication. Approved April 4, 1864.
