sion of time for the collection of said taxes; and the return of the said town treasurer to the county treasurer, within the time limited for the collection of taxes by this act, shall be as valid as if made in pursuance of the direction contained in the original warrant.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Port Washington, in the county of Ozaukee, for the year (A. D.) 1864.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Returned to Receipt 17. SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes in the town of Port Washington, in the county of Ozaukee, for (A. D.) 1864, is hereby extended to the 17th day of March, A. D. 1865: *provided*, that this act shall not be so construed as to extend the time for the payment of state taxes.

SECTION 2. The treasurer of said town shall have the same power and authority to collect the taxes contained in said town tax roll after as before such extension of time for the collection of such taxes; and the return of the town treasurer to the county treasurer, within the time limited for the collection of taxes by this act, shall be as valid as if made pursuant to the direction of the original warrant.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
