

CHAPTER 11.

[Published February 3, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize a special town meeting in the town of Norway, county of Racine, on the 8th day of February, 1864, to vote a tax to pay bounties to volunteers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The special town meeting of the town of Norway, in the county of Racine, held on the 8th day of February, 1864, for the purpose of voting to raise by tax, extra bounties to be paid to volunteers in the military service of the United States, and all votes, acts and resolves of said meeting, are hereby declared legal and valid for all intents and purposes for which said meeting was held, the same and as fully as if the said meeting had been called and conducted in all respects in accordance with the provisions of law then in force relating to that subject ; and all acts done and town orders issued in pursuance of the vote of said meeting, by the officers of said town, or any of them, are hereby declared legal and valid. Town meeting and town orders legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of a certain town meeting held in the town of Williamstown, Dodge county, January 12th, 1865, and to legalize the bonds and orders issued by the officers of said town, to pay bounties to volunteers, and the tax roll for 1864.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. All the proceedings had prior to and at a certain town meeting held in the town of Williamstown, Dodge county, on the 12th day of January, 1865, and the tax voted to be raised to pay bounties to vol- Bounty tax proceedings legalized.
