CHAPTER 159.

AN ACT to vacate an alley in the city of Portage.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The alley as designated in the plat of Vacated. Portage city, recorded by Joshua J. Guppy, county judge, &c., in block two hundred and twenty-one (221,) in said plat, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 160.

[Published May 1, 1865.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of a special tax in the town of Bradford, Rock county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of the special Extended to taxes of the town of Bradford, Rock county, voted for April 8. paying bounties to volunteers, and levied February 27th, 1865, is hereby extended to the first Monday in April next.

SECTION 2. The town treasurer of the town of Brad-Power of treesford, Rock county, shall have the same power to collect all special taxes in arrears in said town, by levy and distress, or otherwise, as provided by law for the collection of such special taxes, within the time specified in the first section of this act, at which time he is hereby required to make return of his warrant and doings in the premises, as is now required by law in such cases.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
