## GENERAL LAWS-CH. 164, 165.

## CHAPTER 164.

## [Published May 1, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 40 of the general laws of 1881, entitled "an act requiring owners of certain machines to guard against accidents."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 40 of the general laws of 1861, entitled "an act requiring owners of certain machines to guard against accidents," is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "The joints or knuckles and jack of the tumbling rods of all threshing machines hereafter used in this state, except S. N. Taylor's knuckle or coupling, patented February 16th, 1864, shall be securely inclosed in a box."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
