

CHAPTER 198.

[Published May 6, 1865.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Burke, Dane county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of all town, county, state and bounty taxes, levied upon the tax roll for the year 1864, in the town of Burke, Dane county, is hereby extended until the twenty-eighth day of March, 1865, and the treasurer of said town shall have the same authority to enforce the collection of such taxes in said town, as is now conferred by law upon town treasurers for such purposes, within the time prescribed by their warrants, up to and including the said twenty-eighth day of March: *provided*, that nothing in this act shall be construed to extend the time for the payment to the county treasurer of the state tax due from said town. Extended to March 28.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 199.

[Published May 8, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize the City bank of Prescott to reduce its capital stock.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The City bank of Prescott is hereby permitted to reduce its capital stock to a sum not less than twenty-five thousand dollars, upon filing with the bank comptroller a certificate from the secretary of state, that said bank has complied with the requirements of subdivision thirteen of an act to amend chapter four hundred and seventy-nine of the general laws of Wisconsin. Capital may be reduced.
