*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***Amendment.**

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 420 of the session laws of 1864, is hereby amended, by striking out of said section all the words which are found therein after the word "provided," and inserting in lieu thereof, "that said exemption shall not extend to any such lands which shall be sold, leased or conveyed, or contracted to be sold; but said company may mortgage and encumber said lands for the purpose of raising funds to build said railroad, without being subject to taxation for the time aforesaid, by reason of such mortgage or encumbrance."

Application.

SECTION 2. This act and the act to which this is amendatory, shall apply to all lands which may be

hereafter acquired by said company under the act of congress granting lands to the state of Wisconsin, to aid in the construction of railroads, approved May 5th, 1864, and the rights of said company in said lands granted and secured to it by the laws of this state.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
