CHAPTER 277.

AN ACT to vacate Webster, Ford and Miller's addition to the city of Beaver Dam.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All the addition to the city of Beaver Vacated. Dam, in the county of Dodge, known, described and recorded as Webster, Ford and Miller's addition to Beaver Dam, is hereby vacated, and shall be designated hereafter as outlot No. (71) seventy-one, of the third (3d) ward of the city of Beaver Dam.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
