

CHAPTER 316.

[Published May 20, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize the governor to sign patents for certain state lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Patents to Fox and Wisconsin rivers improvement land.

SECTION 1. The governor is hereby authorized, upon presentation of the certificate of sale issued by the register of the state land office, to sign and issue patents to the holder of such certificate, for lands appropriated to this state by act of congress approved August 8th, 1846, for the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers, which were sold by the state prior to the organization of the Fox and Wisconsin improvement company.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

CHAPTER 317.

[Published May 20, 1865.]

AN ACT to change the name of Genoa, in the town of Bloomfield, county of Walworth, to Bloomfield.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Name changed.

SECTION 1. The name of Genoa, in the town of Bloomfield, Walworth county, is hereby changed to Bloomfield.

SECTION 2. This act to be in force from and after its passage.
