AN ACT for the relief of the Calumet county agricultural society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby directed when order many to issue an order on the state treasurer, in favor of beissued in favor the Calumet county agricultural society, as provided by section five, chapter fifty-three (53) of the general laws of 1858 : provided, that the annual report of said society for the year 1864, is on file in the office of the secretary of state at the time of the passage of this act.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage.
