SECTION 8. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 861.

[Published April 10, 1865.]

AN ACT to increase the compensation now allowed by law to certain officers and employees of the state prison, and to appropriate a certain sum of money for such purpose.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Per diem of state prison officers and employees.

SECTION 1. The following officers and employees of the state prison, shall each receive for his services the sum of fifty cents per day, in addition to the amount now allowed by law: The deputy warden, the overseers in the several shops, and all other overseers and keepers in the several departments of the prison; which amount shall be paid by the commissioner at the times and in the manner provided in section six of chapter 188 of the revised statutes.

Appropriation.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to Henry Cordier, state prison commissioner, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three thousand dollars, to carry into effect the provisions of this act.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
