west quarter (\frac{1}{2}) of section one (1,) and the east half (\frac{1}{2}) of the southeast quarter (\frac{1}{2}) of section two (2,) and the northeast quarter (\frac{1}{2}) of the northeast quarter (\frac{1}{2}) of section eleven (11,) in township number eleven (11) north, of range number nineteen east, and recorded in the office of register of deeds of said county of Washington, and when so corrected, shall be evidence in any court of law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 239 of the general laws of 1862.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 239 of the general laws of 1862, Repeal

is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Section 9 of chapter 138 of the revised Per diem of clerk statutes, entitled "of costs and fees," is hereby re-of supreme court vived and continued in force, and shall be applicable to the January term, A. D. 1865.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be pub-

lished immediately.
