

CHAPTER 46.

[Published February 28, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of a special town meeting in the town of Lisbon, Waukesha county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The proceedings of a special town meeting in and for the town of Lisbon, in the county of Waukesha, at which a bounty of two hundred dollars each was voted to volunteers to the military service of the United States, and credited to said town, held on 24th day of January, A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty-five, are hereby legalized and declared valid, to all intents and purposes.

Bounty tax proceedings legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 47.

[Published February 24, 1865.]

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of the board of supervisors of the town of Newark, Rock county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That all of the official acts of the supervisors of the town of Newark, Rock county, Wisconsin, in paying bounties to volunteers under the call of the president of the United States for five hundred thousand volunteers, in July, 1864, are hereby legalized and made as binding and of as full force, as if all the requirements of the law had been complied with, and said supervisors and each of them are hereby relieved from any and all liability on account of such acts, respectively.

Acts of supervisors legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
