AN ACT to amend section one of chapter two hundred and seventyone of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to lay out a state road from Monroe, in Green county, to Gratiot, in La Fayette county."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and commissioners. seventy-one of the general laws of 1863, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Charles S. Foster, E. Wescott and D. G. Tuttle are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road from Monroe, in Green county, through lot fifteen, section one, town one, range five east, crossing Spafford branch near its mouth, to Gratriot, in La Fayette county."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
