AN ACT relating to taxes, and amendatory of chapter 108 of the private and local laws of 1858.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter seven of said we for contact chapter one hundred and eight, is hereby amended, by adding thereto as follows: "For every certificate issued as said treasurer in pursuance with this section, he shall receive the sum of fifty cents, which sum shall be added to the cost of said sale, and be included in the amount for which the premises shall be sold."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to amend section one (1) of chapter 154 of the general laws of 1862, entitled "an act providing for a lien for labor and services upon logs and lumber, in certain counties."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 154 of the general Lien for labor laws of 1862, entitled "an act providing for a lien for logs, &c. labor and services upon logs and lumber, in certain counties," is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 1. Any person, company or corporation that may do or perform any labor or services in cutting, falling, hauling, driving, running, rafting, booming, cribbing or towing any logs or timber in the counties of Pierce, St. Croix, Polk, Dallas, Burnett, Douglas, La Pointe, Ashland, Jackson, Clark, La Crosse and Manitowoc, in this state, shall have a lien thereon for the amount due for such labor or services, and the same "
