## CHAPTER 72.

[Published March 4, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of supervisors of St Croix county to appropriate to William Barker, late sheriff thereof, the sum of seventy-five dollars.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of St. Croix county, in said state, are hereby authorized to appropriate to William Barker, late sheriff of said county, the sum of seventy-five dollars, to reimburse him for a reward of the same sum offered and paid by him, as such sheriff, for the apprehension of Adelbert Brockway, who broke jail in April, 1864, by reason of the insufficiency thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 78.

[Published March 4, 1865.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 227 of general laws of 1860, and to revive sections 8 of chapter 190 of the revised statutes, entitled "of prisoners generally, and common jails."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and twenty-seven

of general laws of 1860, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Section 8 of chapter one hundred and ninety of the revised statutes, is hereby revived, reinstated and re-enacted in all its parts.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
