CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the city of Janesville, county of Rock, and state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection and return Extended to of the state, county and bounty taxes in the city of April 1.

Janesville, Rock county, is hereby extended until the first day of April, A. D. 1865, and the tax warrant now in the hands of the city treasurer, shall be in full force until the said first day of April, A. D. 1865, for all the purposes of collecting, levying distress and sale, and returning of said taxes: provided, that nothing in Not to apply to this act shall be construed to extend the time for the payment of the state tax to the county treasurer, as now provided by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
